While our hearts go out to those affected by the Kilauea Volcano activity, Mauna Lani Resort is thankfully unaffected by the volcano. Mauna Lani is located more than 75 miles from the Kilauea Volcano. There is absolutely no reason for current or future guests to change their travel and vacation plans to Mauna Lani.

A few helpful notes from the experts:

- All of the Hawaiian Islands are unaffected by Kilauea Volcano except a remote area on the island of Hawaii's east side. Of the island's 4,028 square miles, less than a 10-square-mile area of the island is impacted by the Kilauea Volcano.
- Air Access: All flights into the Ellison Onizuka Kona International Airport and Hilo International Airport are operating normally.
- Air Quality: The air quality on the Kohala Coast remains clean and safe. In fact, the air quality for the vast majority of the Island of Hawaii remains largely unchanged with this situation. Officials are monitoring air quality near where the lava is flowing, and in those localized areas, the air can be hazardous.
